

Exam Results for 2020

Pupils at Haberdashers' Adams achieved another great set of A Level and GCSE results for 2020.

A total of 155 pupils were entered for A Levels, all studying three or more A Level subjects. Overall the school achieved a 100% pass rate with 53% of A Levels graded A*/A and 77% A* - B grades. Over a third of the pupils successfully achieved A*/A grades in every single one of their A Level subjects while 18 pupils achieved a straight set of A* grades in three or more subjects.

In addition to their A Levels, 76% of A Level pupils also took the Extended Project Qualification with a third achieving an A*/A grade.

93% of the school's A Level pupils who applied to university secured their firm/ insurance choice university, including eight pupils with Oxbridge offers and 17 pupils wishing to study medicine, dentistry and veterinary.

For GCSEs, the school had the largest number of pupils in the school's history with 122 pupils studying ten GCSEs or more subjects. High results were achieved across all of the GCSE subjects. The sciences performed particularly well once again and for the second year running Chemistry topped the results with 90% of entries graded 9 - 7. Likewise 88% of entries in Geography were awarded grades 9 - 7, 89% in Music and 82% in Religious Studies.

Overall, the school achieved a GCSE pass rate of 97% (grades 9 - 5 or A* - C), which is in line with previous years. An impressive 70% of entries were awarded grades 9 - 7 (formerly A* - A) and 47% of entries received the highest grades of 9 - 8 (A*). Out of the total 122 pupils, 29 achieved Grades 9 - 7 (formerly A*/A) in all ten of their subjects and 12 of those achieved Grades 9 - 8 (formerly A*) in all ten subjects.
